-Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery MBBS (IMU)-Applicant will complete the 5 year programme in Malaysia and graduate with MBBS(IMU).

-IMU-PMS Undergraduate-Applicant will transfer to all our Partner Medical Schools other than University of Queensland, University of Warwick and Australia National University after Phase 1.

-IMU-PMS Graduate Entry to University of Queensland (UQ), University of Warwick (UW) and Australia National University (ANU) - if applicant does not have a degree at point of entry into IMU, he/she will have to remain for 1 more year to complete Bachelor of Medical Sciences, a research-based degree before transfer. If applicant has a degree at point of entry, he/she can transfer directly to UQ or UW after completion of Phase 1.

-Please note that applicants are not allowed to change their options after course commences.
