- A. Chiropractic Services

i. Dental screening and oral hygiene education

BENEFITTING the marginal and less-privileged communities

- 1. Through IMU Cares outreach programme, marginalised and less-privileged communities will be able to benefit from the services available at the IMU Community Centre.
- 2. Eligible patients with household income less than RM5,000 per month can apply for the Khazanah IHH Healthcare Fund (KIHF)

3. HOW to Apply:

- i. Applicant's household income not more than RM5,000 per month
- ii. Applicant with household income marginally above RM5,000 per month will be assessed on case to case basis e.g.
 - o Number of dependents
 - o Number of family members who are sick or handicapped
 - Cost of treatment
- iii. Applicant / parents / legal guardians must be able to provide documents for a complete application (if applicable)
 - o Parents / Legal guardians NRIC
 - o Child's birth certificate
 - o 3 months' salary slip or income tax statement
 - EPF statement
 - Note: Applicant/s without payslip must be recommended by local community head or social welfare officer with a letter of authorization / verification from the management on the applicant's information.

4. Coverage for Treatment

- Covers primary treatment and any follow-ups related of the primary treatment. Does not include any other medical condition that the individual is born with or caused by any other external factors not related to the actual treatment
- ii. Applicable to acute treatment lasting 6 weeks and below
- iii. Special cases will be taken into consideration
