The MoU's main aims are for IMU and SEAMEO RECFON to strengthen medical and health research and development, jointly publish and present scientific data, exchange research materials pertaining to nutrition and food safety and conduct joint training in the areas of nutrition and food safety.

The agreement also includes postgraduate research and student exchanges through field visits, internships, and attendance to courses and other learning events.
