

2021 IMU Art Competition Organised by Centre for Bioethics and Humanities


Rules and Regulations

Participants are subject to the terms and conditions below but are otherwise free to interpret the theme inany way they choose.

- 1. This competition is open to all students registered in Malaysian public or private institutions of higher education only.
- 2. Participants must <u>not</u> have previously won any of the top 3 prizes in the past IMU Art Competition.
- 3. No registration fees are imposed.
- 4. Each participant is allowed to submit one entry only to the annual IMU Art Competition.
- 5. Each entry must be original in concept, design and execution and must be unpublished workscreated by the participant.
- 6. Each entry must be an individual work. Collaborative work is not accepted.
- 7. Accepted mediums for the two-dimensional artwork are as follows:
- Paintings: oil, acrylics, watercolour, etc.
- Drawings: coloured pencil, pencil, ink, marker, pastels, charcoal (It is recommended that charcoaland pastel drawings be fixed.)
- Collages: must be two dimensional
- Prints: lithographs, silkscreen, block prints
- Mixed Media: use of more than two mediums such as pencil, ink, watercolour, etc.

Artwork guidelines

- 1. Each entry must be in A2 (420x594mm) size only.
- 2. Only two-dimensional entries that adhere to the size restriction set will be accepted.
- 3. Artwork when submitted should not be damaged in any way (creased, folded, stained, stapled,rolled, etc).
- 4. Each entry must be mounted on a hard mounting board of your colour choice. There must be aborder of 5cm on all sides between your artwork and the frame (see example below).
- 5. Artwork done on canvas with frame need <u>not</u> be mounted.



General information

- 1. All entries submitted (including all copyright and intellectual property therein) shall be deemed the property of IMU and will not be returned.
- 2. Participants upon submission of their entries transfer all rights in and to the artwork submitted including all copyrights and intellectual property rights to IMU absolutely and agree to the officialrules and regulation of this art competition.
- 3. Participants upon submission of their entries agree that IMU may reproduce collateral materials (including derivate works) such as books, postcards, calendars, etc. based on or incorporating theentries/artwork. All entries are intended for non-commercial use only.
- 4. Entries (including collateral materials and derivative works) may be displayed on IMU and IMU related websites and in publicity campaigns (such as calendars, cards, posters, etc) for IMU relatedactivities and purposes.
- 5. By submitting an entry, the Participant shall be deemed to agree to the use by IMU of the participant's name, age, and personal description, including photographs, for advertising and promotional purposes.

Submission Guidelines

- 1. Complete the online registration form.
- 2. Submit is digital copy of your artwork to artsfest@imu.edu.my
- 3. Submit a physical of your artwork to Student Services Department, International Medical University, No.126 Jalan Jalil Perkasa 19, Bukit Jalil, KL through the school or individually during office hours, before the deadline.

Judging & Prize-Giving

- 1. A panel of judges appointed by IMU will select the winning entries which will be eligible to receive ash prizes.
- 2. The decision of the judges is final and no discussion on this issue will be entertained.
- 3. The judging criteria will be based on originality, creativity, artistic impression and interpretation of subject matter.
- 4. Winners will be notified through email and must be present at the prize-giving ceremony. No part of the prize money will be handed over to representatives.
