Programme Structure

This programme includes on-site, off-site and e-learning activities with compulsory on-site activities at IMU School of Dentistry delivered over twelve months. Clinical activities provide the option of treating patients at IMU's Oral Health Centre or in their own clinics. Upon completion of clinical cases, students can attend final assessment according to the scheduled dates in the academic calendar.

Entry Requirements

- Bachelor of Dental Surgery or equivalent qualification. Registered as a dental surgeon with the Malaysian Dental Council (MDC) or equivalent in the student's home country. Having at least two years post-graduation clinical experience.
- Participants who possess a current Annual Practice Certificate (APC) to practise dentistry in Malaysia.
- Participants who are eligible to practise dentistry in Malaysia with a Temporary Practice Certificate (TPC).
- All candidates need to be issued an APC or TPC (whichever is applicable) that is specific to the IMU Oral Health Centre (OHC) to be eligible to attend the clinical sessions in the centre during the period of the study.
- Able to demonstrate an interest in the use of dental implants with appropriate baseline knowledge and skills in oral surgery and restorative dentistry. (Evidence such as CPD certificates must be provided).

English Language Requirements

For International Students (only one required)

- 1. IELTS : Band score 5.0; or
- 2. TOEFL (iBT) : Overall score of 42; or
- 3. Cambridge English : Advanced (CAE) : Overall score of 154; or
- 4. Cambridge English : Proficiency (CPE) : Overall score of 154; or
- 5. Cambridge Linguaskill : Overall score of 160; or
- 6. Pearson Test of English (PTE) : Overall score of 47;

The following categories of students are exempted from the above requirements:

^{1.} International students from countries in which English is the first language.

^{2.} International students who graduated from any Malaysian or other institutions where the curriculum is delivered in English.
