Assessments

Assessments vary throughout the programme from written assignments (critical reviews, reflection, case studies) to presentations. Regular feedback will be provided to enhance performance. Students in the Master programme are also required to submit a research proposal, conduct the research upon approval and write a dissertation.

Entry Requirements

- A Bachelor's Degree in the field or related fields with a minimum CGPA of 2.50 or equivalent, as accepted by the University Senate; or
- A Bachelor's Degree in the field or related fields or equivalent with a minimum CGPA of 2.00 and not meeting a CGPA of 2.50, can be accepted subject to rigorous internal assessment

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English Language Requirements

For International Students (only one required)

1. IELTS: Band score 5.0; or

2. TOEFL (iBT): Overall score of 42; or

3. Cambridge English: Advanced (CAE): Overall score of 154; or

4. Cambridge English: Proficiency (CPE): Overall score of 154; or

5. Cambridge Linguaskill: Overall score of 160; or

6. Pearson Test of English (PTE): Overall score of 47;

The following categories of students are exempted from the above requirements:

1. International students from countries in which English is the first language.

2. International students who graduated from any Malaysian or other institutions where the curriculum is delivered in English.
