# Scholarships

The International Medical University (IMU) offers 3 types of scholarships:

1. IMU-Merit Scholarship
2. IMU-Need Scholarship
3. Pantai-Gleneagles Scholarship

## 1. IMU-Merit Scholarship

This scholarship is awarded to students demonstrating outstanding academic excellence, extra curriculum participation and leadership qualities. Merit Scholarship is available to cover:

1. Full Tuition Fee (100%) for full duration of programme
2. Partial Tuition Fee (50%) for full duration of programme

Scholarship application will be strictly by invitation only upon receiving an offer letter for admission into the specific programme at IMU and submission of final result.

This scholarship is only applicable for the Malaysian applying for LOCAL option.

## Eligibility

1. Open to Malaysian students only.
2. Applicant must be applying for the First Degree programme.
3. Scholarship application will be strictly by invitation only upon receiving an offer letter for admission and meeting the above merit criteria mentioned above.

## How to Apply

1. Upon successful application and meeting the scholarship's eligibility requirements, student will be invited to apply for the scholarship via email.
2. Documents required for application are SPM/O-Level Certificate, Pre-U Transcript, IELTS/MUET, Co-Curriculum Certificate with cGPA and Personal Statement.
3. If you have received a conditional offer, kindly submit your final results to Admissions Department before the closing date to be eligible for the scholarship.
4. After the closing date, selected candidates will be called for an interview.

## 2. IMU-Need Scholarship

This scholarship is awarded to students who are facing financial difficulties and demonstrating good academic achievement despite the challenging situation.

This scholarship covers 100% of tuition fees and is only applicable for the Malaysian applying for LOCAL option.

- Applicant with involvement in the community (based on ECA records) will have an added advantage.

### How to Apply

  - IMU Conditional Letter of Offer, if applicant has received an offer for an undergraduate programme at IMU
  - Evidence of previous and current financial assistance (Scholarship / Loan) received
  - Latest 3 years of Parents' / Guardians' BE Form / B Form of Lembaga Hasil Dalam Negeri (LHDN)
    - Latest 3 months of personal Bank Statements of Parents / Guardian
    - Latest 3 months of company's Bank Statements of Parents / Guardian for self-employed Parents / Guardian
    - Full latest EPF Statement of Parents / Guardian
    - Latest 3 months of Parents' / Guardians' pay slips
    - Declaration of Unemployment by Commissioner of Oath for unemployed Parents / Guardian
    - Copy of Parents' Death / Divorce Certificate
    - Latest 3 months of house water bill
    - Latest 3 months of house electricity bill

### Scholarship Details

- Scholarships will be awarded, with bonding, subject to the programme.
- All scholarships will only cover the tuition fees and no allowance for living expenses, books and study-related equipment is provided.
- The amount will be disbursed on a semester to semester basis.
- Students are required to maintain the required minimum cGPA of 3.30 per semester in order to continue with the scholarship. Failing which, the scholarship may be discontinued with immediate effect.
- Students who withdraw (academic and non-academic reasons) without completing the programme will be required to repay the amount that has been disbursed for the financial award given.
- Repeat modules will not be covered and continuation of the financial award will be on a case by case basis.
- IMU Scholarship Committee may vary the selection requirements as and when it deems necessary.

### 3. Pantai Gleneagles Scholarship

This scholarship is a need-based scholarship designed to assist students from a family with dire financial difficulties.

Candidates who meet the scholarship eligibility requirements as stated below will need to apply for admission first and secure a conditional offer letter.

### Scholarship Details

1. Scholarships will be awarded, with bonding, subject to the programme.

# Financial Assistance

## National Higher Education Fund (NHEF) or Perbadanan Tabung Pendidikan Tinggi Nasional (PTPTN)

### Terms and Conditions

1. The PTPTN loan is ONLY available for the local option programmes conducted fully in Malaysia.
2. For the credit transfer programmes (Medicine & Dentistry), PTPTN will ONLY cover the duration the student is in Malaysia.
3. The PTPTN management board charges an administration cost of 1% per year of the remaining loan sum.
4. Students will be required to obtain insurance coverage for the loan and the premium will be deducted from each semester's loan by PTPTN.

### Eligibility to Apply

1. Malaysian (45 and below).
2. Must not be sponsored presently by any sponsor body.
3. PTPTN does not sponsor students for the same level of studies twice.
4. Existing students must have 1 remaining year in IMU. Therefore, application must be made at least in the following semesters:
  - Medicine, Dentistry (IMU Option) - Semester 8.
  - Medicine, Dentistry (Partner School Option) - Semester 3.
  - Pharmacy, Nursing, Dietetics with Nutrition, Chiropractic, Chinese Medicine - Semester 6.
  - Psychology, Pharmaceutical Chemistry, Biomedical Science, Medical Biotechnology, Nutrition - Semester 4.
  - Nursing Science – within the first year of study.
5. Students who have received PTPTN loan through previous colleges/universities but have withdrawn/not completed their courses, are required to terminate the contract and make full repayment at PTPTN office before new application can be made.

### To apply online, student needs to:

1. CIMB Account
  - Personal Saving Account (only student's name).
  - Opened at any CIMB branch.
2. SSPN Account
  - Minimum of RM20.00.
3. PIN Number
  - RM5.00.
  - Valid for 6 months.

## Documents to be submitted to PTPTN after online application approval:

1. PTPTN Agreement and Letter of Offer which will be sent to the student's registered email and can be found in PTPTN log in account.
2. Setem Hasil – 2 pieces (RM10 each).
3. A copy of IMU Letter of Offer from Admission Office. Conditional Letter of Offer is also accepted.

## PTPTN Subsequent Loan Disbursement Schedule

1. Loan will be disbursed following the below schedule every semester according to the student's result and transcript release date.
  - Student needs to pass minimum CGPA of 2.00 and Grade C (for MBBS programme).
  - Schedule of payment as determined by PTPTN is as below:

2. Please take note that PTPTN does not release payment of loan according to IMU fee payment deadline. Students are responsible to pay tuition fees of every semester to IMU by deadline stated in the invoice.

## Public Service Department (PSD) Jabatan Perkhidmatan Awam (JPA)

- Program Khas Lulusan Sijil Pelajar Malaysia Dalam Negara
- This is a convertible loan programme for SPM high-achiever students to continue studies in local university
- Terms and conditions apply

## Majlis Amanah Rakyat (MARA)

### General Term

- Eligible for Malay and Bumiputera students only.
- Applicant and parents are not blacklisted by MARA.
- Applicant does not receive financial support / sponsorship from any agency for the same level of study.

### How to Apply

- Submit an online application via MARA website.

## Yayasan Sarawak

### General Terms

- Only for Sarawak native (one of the parents must be Sarawakian).
- Submit a PTPTN loan offer letter to apply loan increment.
- Need two guarantors who have permanent employment and are not above 55 years of age.
- Have to submit a fee structure for tuition fee.
- Loan repayment after 12 months' completion of study.
- The initial disbursement will be issued upon receipt of the complete document.

### Time of Application

- Application open for the whole year.

### How to Apply

- Send documents required to Yayasan Sarawak.

## Hong Leong Foundation

### General Term

- It is open to Malaysian citizens aged between 17 - 25 years who have sat for the SPM/STPM examination.
- Eligible for those who pursue undergraduate studies (1st degree) in any course in a degree programme in Malaysia.
- Those who are currently in a degree programme (Year 1, 2 or 3) are eligible to apply.
- Not eligible for Pre-U courses.
- Academic requirements:
  - SPM : Minimum 8As.
  - STPM / Matriculation / A-Level / Foundation / Diploma / Degree: Minimum CGPA of 3.50 (Please convert the scoring to CGPA when applying if your scoring is not currently in this format).
- Scholarship is only for full-time courses conducted in Malaysia only.

### Time of Application

- Application will be open from **1 April to 31 May**.

## Employee Provident Fund (EPF) Kumpulan Wang Simpanan Pekerja (KWSP)

### General Information

This scheme allows qualified EPF members to withdraw their savings from Account No. 2 to finance their children's / self study. Withdrawals are allowed for local and overseas education. Maximum withdrawals will depend on the amount of funds the parents / student have in their Account No. 2, as well as how much the university's fees are. Members can apply for this scheme every semester (two withdrawal in one academic year), or every academic year (one time withdrawal in one academic year), or overall module fees.

### How to Apply

1. Collect KWSP withdrawal form from the IMU cashier on ground floor.
2. Submit the completed form to IMU cashier for processing (3 working days required).
3. Submit all supporting documents to KWSP for approval.

## Kuok Foundation

### General Terms & Conditions

1. Only Malaysian citizens are eligible to apply.
2. Kuok Foundation study awards are for needy students only.
3. Applicants should possess good academic qualifications and should be active in school.
4. This financial aid is offered to all students pursuing local degree programmes which are MQA certified.

### Time of Application

Application is usually available in July. Kuok Foundation will announce in the local news and their website for the application opening.

### How to Apply

Apply and submit online at [apply.kuokfoundation.org](http://apply.kuokfoundation.org). After applicants have submitted their application forms online, applicants MUST ALSO courier / send by Pos Laju or by hand the PRINTED COPY OF THE APPLICATION FORMS together with supporting documents to the Foundation's office.

All applications must be submitted before the closing date stipulated in the announcement. Late applications will not be considered. Only shortlisted candidates will be notified for interview.

### Type of Award

Interest free study loan or ½ loan ½ grant. No service bond.

### Value of Award

The funding is up to RM50,000 per year (depending on courses undertaken and value is subject to revision from time to time).

### Repayment of Loan

By monthly installments commencing one (1) month after completion of course.

## Maybank Education Loan / Financing-I

### Eligibility
