1. IMU-Merit Scholarship

This scholarship is awarded to students demonstrating outstanding academic excellence, extra-curricular participation and leadership qualities. IMU-Merit Scholarship is available to cover:

- 1. Full Tuition Fee (100%) for full duration of programme
- 2. Partial Tuition Fee (50%) for full duration of programme

Candidates who meet the scholarship eligibility requirements as stated below may proceed to apply via online application through our IMU website.

This scholarship is only applicable for Malaysian applying for LOCAL option.

- Repeat modules will not be covered and continuation of the financial award will be on a case by case basis.
- 6. IMU Scholarship Committee may vary the selection requirements as and when it deems necessary.

2. IMU-Need Scholarship

This scholarship is awarded to students who are facing financial difficulties and demonstrating good academic achievement despite the challenging situation. This scholarship covers 100% of tuition fees and is only applicable for the Malaysian applying for LOCAL option.

3. Pantai-Gleneagles Scholarship

This scholarship is a need-based scholarship designed to assist students from a family with dire financial difficulties.

Financial Assistance

National Higher Education Fund (NHEF) or Perbadanan Tabung Pendidikan Tinggi Nasional (PTPTN)

General Information

- The PTPTN loan is ONLY available for the local option programmes conducted fully in Malaysia.
- 2. For the credit transfer programmes (Medicine & Dentistry), PTPTN will ONLY cover the duration the student is in Malaysia.
- 3. The PTPTN management board charges an administration cost of 1% per year of the remaining loan sum.
- Students will be required to obtain insurance coverage for the loan and the premium will be deducted from each semester's loan by PTPTN.

Eligibility to Apply

- 1. Malaysian (45 and below).
- 2. Must not be sponsored presently by any sponsor body.
- 3. PTPTN does not sponsor students for the same level of studies twice.
- 4. Existing students must have 1 remaining year in IMU. Therefore, application must be made at least in the following semesters:
 - Medicine, Dentistry (IMU Option) Semester 8.
 - Medicine, Dentistry (Partner School Option) Semester 3.
 - Pharmacy, Nursing, Dietetics with Nutrition, Chiropractic, Chinese Medicine - Semester 6.
 - Psychology, Pharmaceutical Chemistry, Biomedical Science, Medical Biotechnology, Nutrition, Digital Health - Semester 4.

Students who have received PTPTN loan through previous colleges/universities but have withdrawn/not completed their courses, are required to terminate the contract and make full repayment at PTPTN office before new application can be made.

To apply online, student needs to:

 - Opened at any CIMB branch or online via CIMB website.
- 2. Download myPTPTN Application
 - Student proceed to apply for loan online via myPTPTN application.
- 3. SSPN Account
 - Opened at PTPTN / MAYBANK or online via myPTPTN application.
 - Minimum deposit of RM20.00.
- 4. PIN Number
 - Can be purchased for RM5.00 online via myPTPTN application.

Public Service Department (PSD) Jabatan Perkhidmatan Awam (JPA)

- Program Khas Lepasan Sijil Pelajaran Malaysia Dalam Negara
- This is a convertible loan programme for SPM high-achiever students to continue studies in local university
- Terms and conditions apply

Majlis Amanah Rakyat (MARA) Eligibility

- Applicable for Malay and Bumiputera students only.
- Applicant and parents are not blacklisted by MARA.
- Applicant does not receive financial support / sponsorship from any agency for the same level of study.

Yayasan Negeri

Eligibility

- Financial assistance is provided for each state based on applicant's birth state.
- Requirement is subjected to respective state.
- Financial assistance mentioned can be in the form of scholarship, loan, one-off financial assistance and others depending on respective state.

Yayasan Tunku Abdul Rahman (YTAR) Scholarship

Eligibility

- Provides monthly allowance and annual allowance only.
- Provides leadership development programme. Scholars will attend camps and workshops to hone their leadership skills, critical thinking, and interpersonal skills
- Applicable for Malaysian citizen only.
- Has completed their Pre-University studies and has at least two years of their undergraduate studies remaining.

Time of Application

• Application will be open in February.

Hong Leong Foundation

Eligibility

- It is open to Malaysian citizens aged between 17 25 years who have sat for the SPM/STPM examination.
- Applicable for those who pursue undergraduate studies (1st degree) in any course in a degree programme in Malaysia.
- Those who are currently in a degree programme (Year 1, 2 or 3) are eligible to apply.
- Not applicable for Pre-U courses.
- Academic requirements:
 - SPM: Minimum 8As.
 - STPM / Matriculation / A-Level / Foundation / Diploma / Degree: Minimum cGPA of 3.50 (Please convert the scoring to CGPA when applying if your scoring is not currently in this format).
- Scholarship is only for full-time courses conducted in Malaysia only.

Malaysian Community & Education Foundation (MCEF)

Eligibility

- Provides education loan up to RM 80,000 to student with 0% interest.
- Eligible for Malaysian students with financial difficulties.
- Applicants must be pursuing local degree programme with good academic qualifications.

Employee Provident Fund (EPF) Kumpulan Wang Simpanan Pekerja (KWSP)

Eligibility

This scheme allows qualified EPF members to withdraw their savings from Account No. 2 to finance their children's / self study. Withdrawals are allowed for local and overseas education. Maximum withdrawals will depend on the amount of funds the parents / student have in their Account No. 2, as well as how much the university's fees are. Members can apply for this scheme every semester (two withdrawal in one academic year), or every academic year (one time withdrawal in one academic year), or overall module fees.

- 1. Applicable for Undergraduate and Postgraduate programmes
- 2. Not applicable for Foundation programmes

How to Apply

- 1. Collect KWSP withdrawal form from the IMU cashier on ground floor.
- 2. Submit the completed form to IMU cashier for processing (3 working days required).
- 3. Submit all supporting documents to KWSP for approval.

Application is usually available in July. Kuok Foundation will announce in the local news and their website for the application opening.

How to Apply

Apply and submit online at apply.kuokfoundation.org. After applicants have submitted their application forms online, applicants must also courier / send by Pos Laju or by hand the printed copy of the application forms together with supporting documents to the Foundation's office.

All applications must be submitted before the closing date stipulated in the announcement. Late applications will not be considered. Only shortlisted candidates will be notified for interview.
