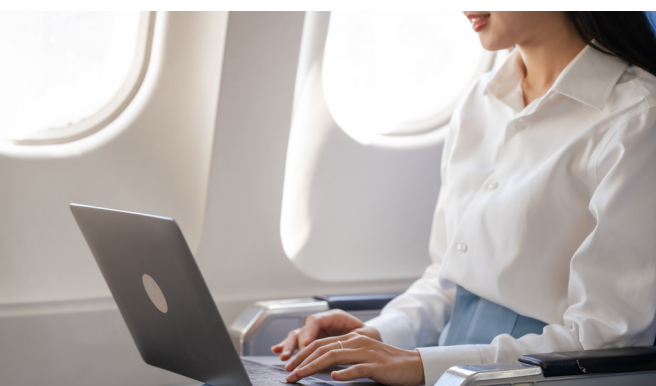
Gateway to Overseas Exposure
